

Anne Street, Honorary Professor University of Queensland, was awarded an AM (Member in the General Division of the Order of Australia) in June, "for significant service to science education in the field of mathematics". Anne was CMSA President from 1996 to 1998 and Editor-in-Chief of the Australasian Journal of Combinatorics from 1990 to 2001.

Professor Cheryl Praeger, University of Western Australia, was elected recently to Honorary Membership of the London Mathematical Society, an award to distinguished mathematicians who are not normally resident within the United Kingdom. The Journal is now online only, free for readers and authors (so it is a "diamond open access" journal). There are three volumes per year, with each volume closing in February, June and October, matching the time of publication of the old paper volumes. Volumes are currently being uploaded in three batches. All three parts of Volume 60 are now online.
