(7) Other Business.

Ian Wanless was thanked for his work as CMSA President over the past three years.

A general informal discussion then took place which included the following.

Brian Alspach enquired as to whether there were any plans on how to use the surplus. It was pointed out that the growing surplus was due almost entirely to AJC profits. Council was looking at a number of options including reduced or subsidized registration fees for PhD students at future conferences. Some money was likely to be spent on new webpages for the AJC.

Kyle Pula asked whether there were any short or long term plans to convert the AJC to an electronic journal. Ian Wanless explained that this had been discussed by some members of council and there were no short term plans to do so. Such a change could occur in the long term.

Ernest Ruet d'Auteuil asked about the mechanism for joining CMSA as a life member. Darryn Bryant explained that anyone wishing to apply for life membership should email the secretary, and that applications are considered at the following CMSA council meeting. Council meets three times per year. Information concerning CMSA membership applications is available at the CMSA website.

Chris Rodger asked what CMSA council has been doing over the past year. [information is available in the Council Report (link above), and in the minutes of council meetings (available on request from the secretary)]. Brian mentioned that an amount of time had been spent on discussions concerning 33ACCMCC. Ian Wanless mentioned the ERA, scheduling of future ACCMCC conferences [venues have been arranged and confirmed for 2010 and 2011, and tentative planning for 2012 has occurred], and National (Australian) mathematics curriculum.
